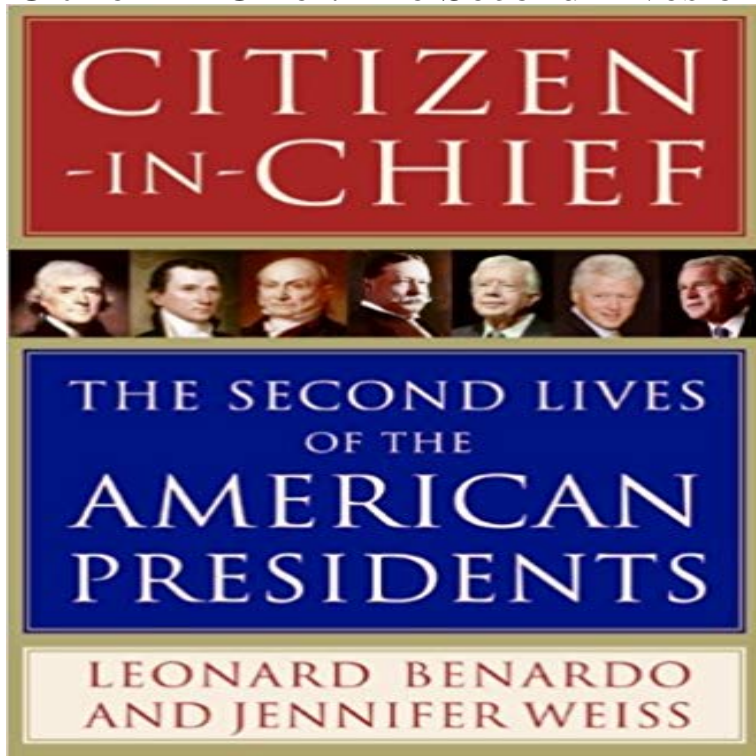


Citizen-in-Chief: The Second Lives of the American Presidents
