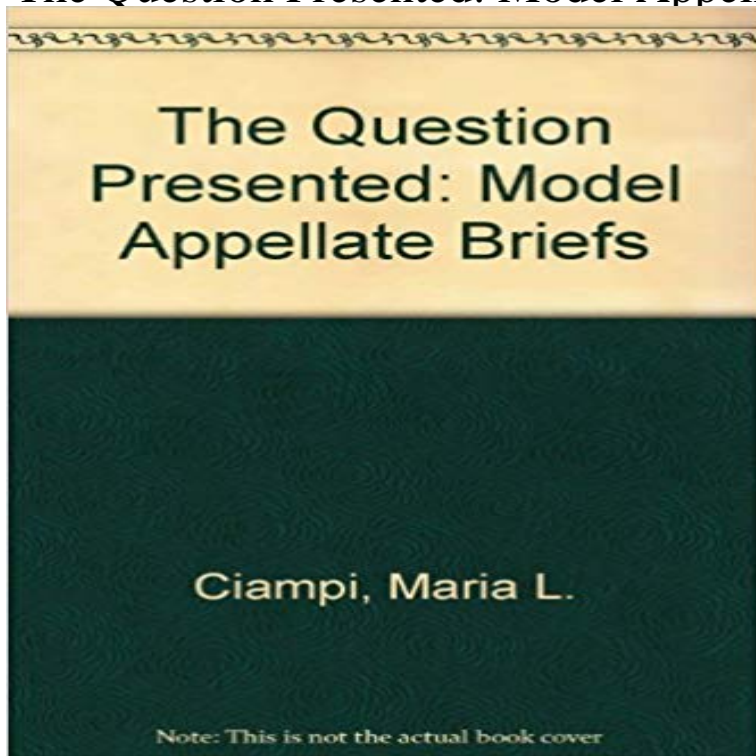


The Question Presented: Model Appellate Briefs
