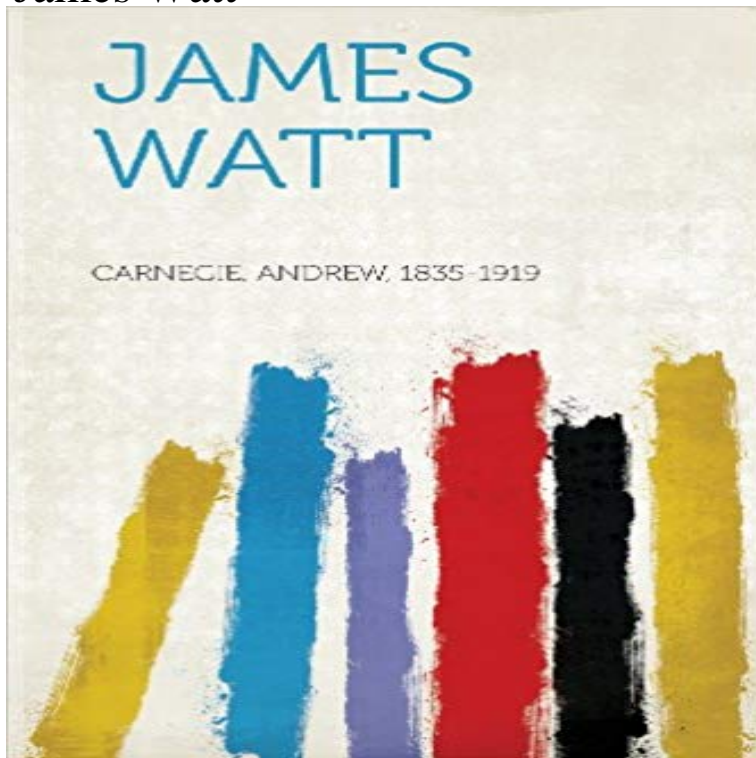


## James Watt
