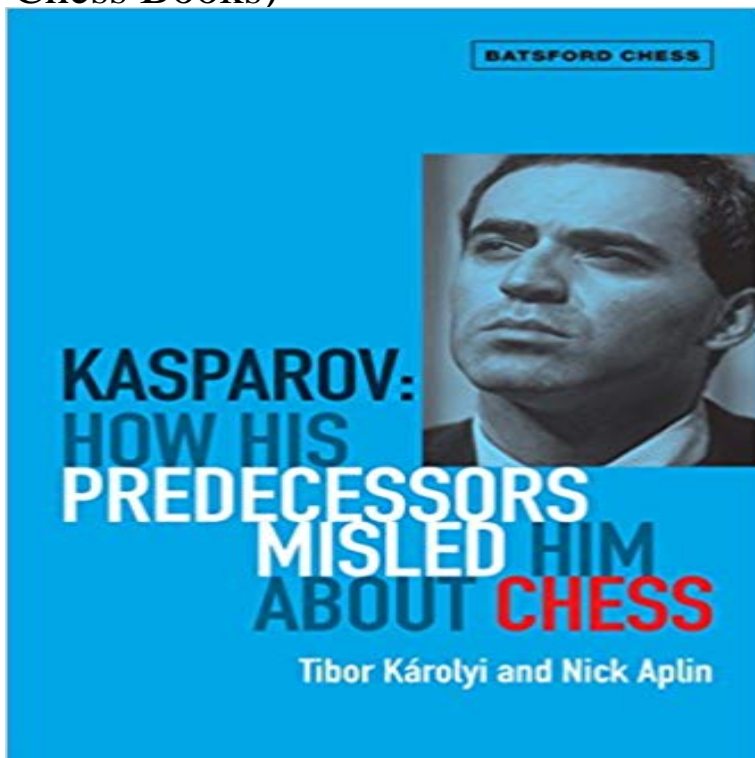


Kasparov: How His Predecessors Misled Him About Chess (Batsford Chess Books)
