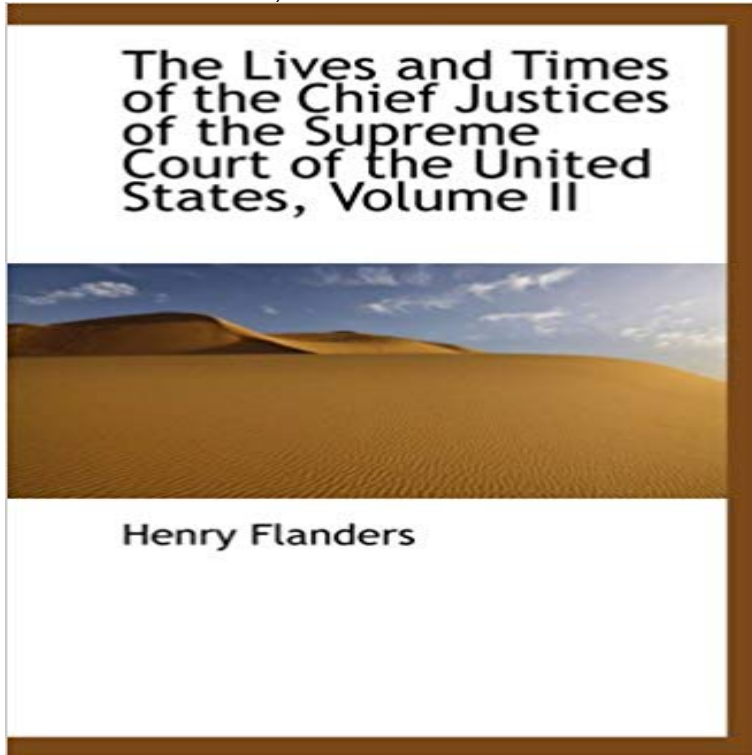


The Lives and Times of the Chief Justices of the Supreme Court of the United States, Volume II
