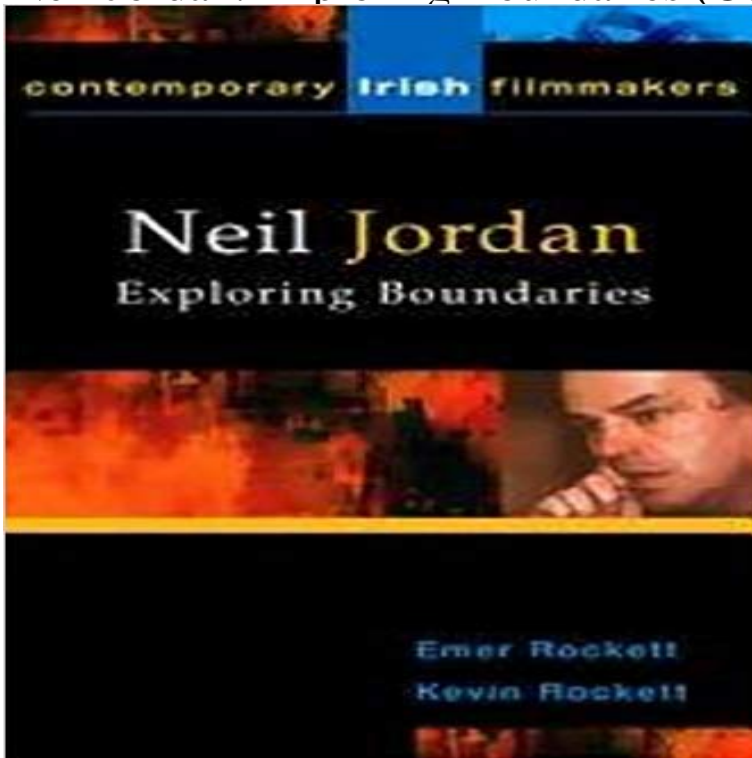


Neil Jordan: Exploring Boundaries (Contemporary Irish Filmmakers)
