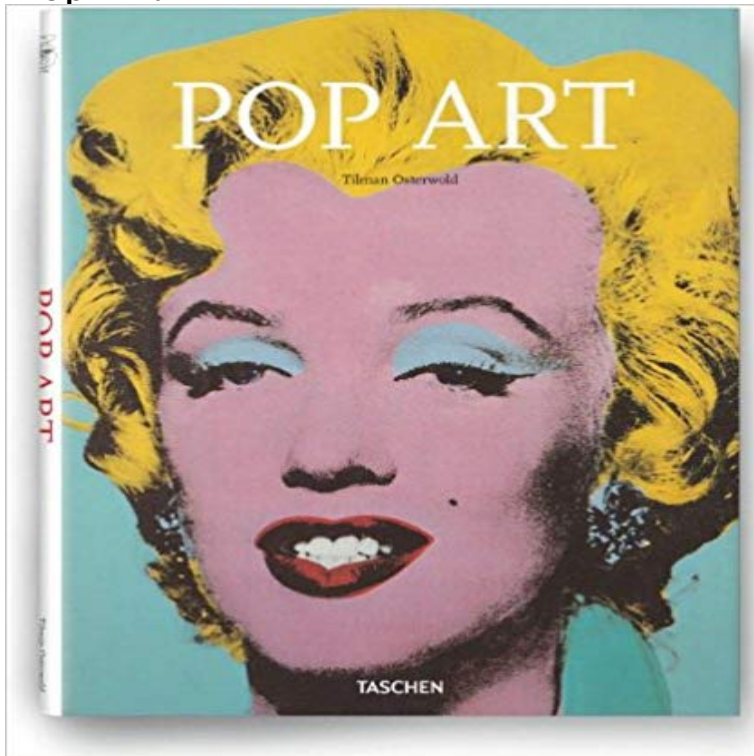


Pop Art
