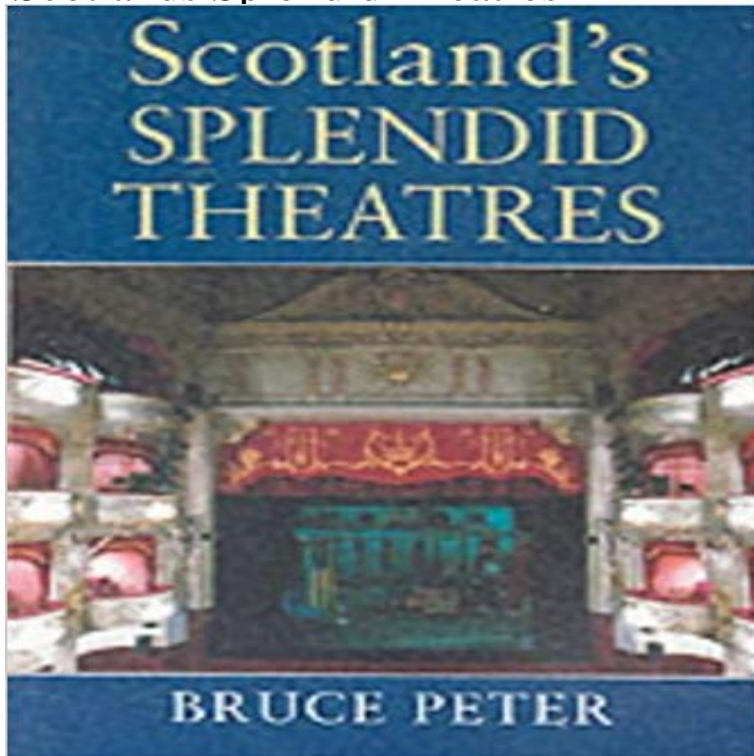


Scotlands Splendid Theatres
