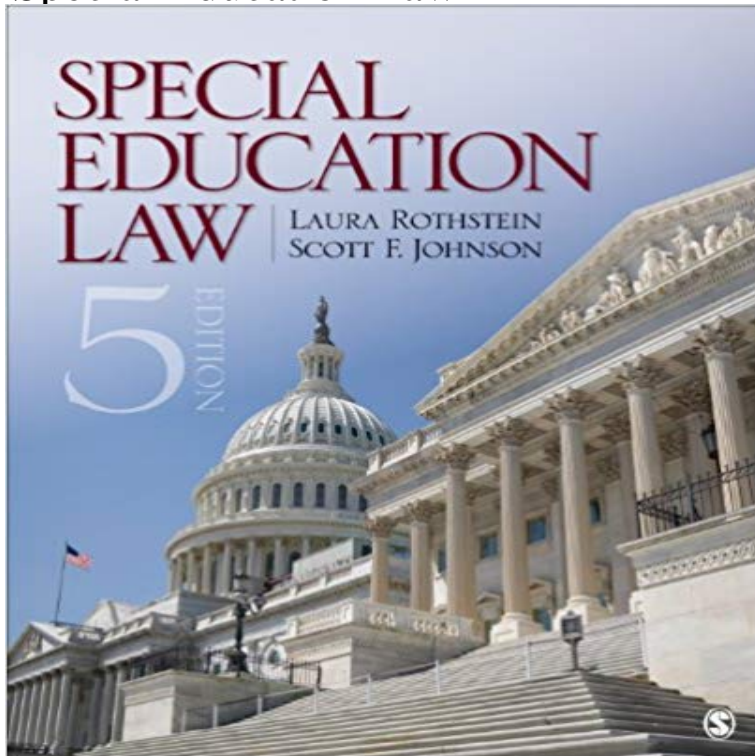


Special Education Law
