
## Sympathy for the Devil: Art and Rock and Roll Since 1967

Organized regionally by cultural centers including London, New York, Los Angeles, and Cologne, the essays examine rock and rolls style, celebrity, and identity politics in art; the experience, energy, and sense of devotion rock music inspires; and the dual role that many individuals play in both the sonic and visual realms. Presenting work that defies a more literal interpretation of the theme and instead suggests the style, energy, and attitude that has come to be associated with rock and roll, this fascinating volume is essential for admirers of contemporary art and culture.
