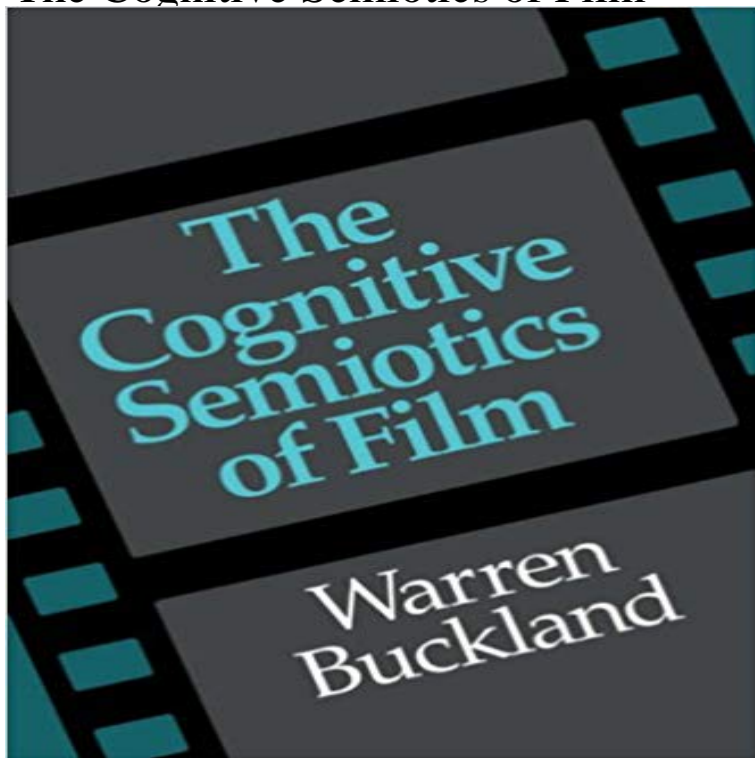


The Cognitive Semiotics of Film
