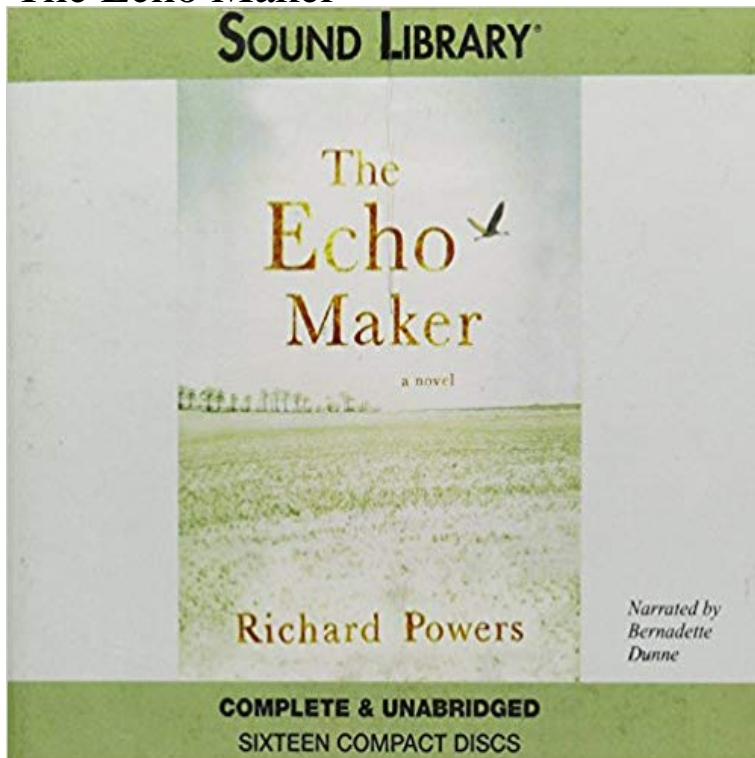


The Echo Maker
